INTRODUCTION

Welcome to your new Port St. Lucie Civic Center. The Civic Center is a unique, state-of-the-art facility like no other on the Treasure Coast. The 100,000 square foot facility is located on the southeast corner of U.S. Highway 1 and Walton Road in Port St. Lucie, and anchors City Center, a new mixed-use development which will feature hotels, restaurants, offices, shops, and condominiums.

The Civic Center has space for any special event whether it is a conference, wedding, birthday party, or trade show. With our on-site catering service, the sky is the limit. The Emerald Ballroom, at 12,625 sq. ft., and the Ruby Conference Hall, at 6,275 sq. ft., are the ideal venues for wedding receptions, graduations, proms, corporate trainings/luncheons, and so much more. The Civic Center is also versatile and unique in that it has a Fitness Center, Gymnasium, Game Room, Raquetball Courts, Art Gallery, and many other amenities. The Civic Center was designed to enhance the quality of life in Port St. Lucie by providing activities and programs for our growing community.

NAMING RIGHTS

Gymnasium - 12,000 sq.ft.
Lobby/Terrace - 6,000 sq.ft.
Ruby Conference Hall - 6,275 sq.ft.
Art Gallery - 2,000 sq.ft.
