**The Selection Process** – Food vendors will be selected based on the max number and the first to submit their application in each category. **All applications must be submitted by fax, email, or in person.**

### **Vendor Rules:**

- ◆ Vendors must keep their space open all hours of the festival rain or shine.
- ◆ Vendors must not accept cash **TOKEN ONLY**. If a food is found taken cash they will not be allow to be a vendor at future events.
- ◆ Vendor must remove all trash at the end of the event. There is a dumpster in the back of the Civic Center.
- ◆ By submitting an application, you agree to and accept all festival terms and conditions.
