2. Copy of the Current Recorded Deed.
3. A legible 8-1/2- x 11 or 8-1/2 x 14-inch site plan (use appropriate scale) clearly showing the following information:
 - a. Sealed Survey showing improvements in the easement
 - b. Signed and Sealed description of the area in the easement written by Licensed Surveyor
 - c. Legal Description
 - d. Label and Dimension the Easement
 - e. Label and Dimension “Encroachment” Feature on all sides
4. Letters from the Utility Companies giving permission for the encroachment (see attached)
5. A check for the application fee plus the recording fees made payable to the City of Port St. Lucie. The application fee is \$360.00 and the St. Lucie County Recording Fee is as follows: \$10.00 first page, \$8.50 each additional page. Total for Application and Recording Fees will be calculated by the Engineering Department *Total may vary based on number of pages being recorded.
