

City Council Capsules for May 14, 2007

May 17, 2007

At their May 14 meeting, the Port St. Lucie City Council:

Accepted a design for the future intersection at Port St. Lucie Boulevard and Becker Road, that will be regulated by a traffic light instead of a round-about circle.

Declared a fire-damaged house on Taurus Lane, and another house on West Virginia Drive, to be a public nuisance, setting the legal groundwork for the houses to be destroyed or made safe again.

Agreed to a change in the design plan for the city-funded Torrey Pines Institute that will allow additional space on the building's third floor. The building is now under construction in western PSL.

Approved a plan to spend approximately \$413,000 for odor control and security measures at the Westport Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Presented awards to 18 elementary school children for creating posters to promote the city's recycling message.
