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RECAP OF JULY 10 PSL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Port St. Lucie, FL – July 12, 2007 – At their July 10 meeting, the Port St. Lucie City Council:

- Gave final approvals to several million dollars worth major roadway construction projects citywide that will begin within 90 days. The projects include sections of the Crosstown Parkway, interchanges at I-95, Village Parkway in the city's southwest annexation area and Rosser Boulevard. The various projects will take anywhere from 18 to 30 months to complete.
- Discussed state-imposed budget cuts that are likely to force reductions in city services and programs, reductions in staffing levels, and other hardships.
- Asked City Manager Don Cooper to draft a memo detailing various cost-cutting alternatives, to be discussed in future Council meetings.
