

## **City Council approves several sidewalk projects**

**April 25th, 2007**

The Port St. Lucie City Council approved a plan to begin construction of sidewalks in the 10 most critically needed places in the city on Monday. The 10 areas were determined in a study by the city's Engineering Department, with help from the St. Lucie County School District, and the city's police and public works departments. Money for the projects is expected to come from a grant by St. Lucie County. All of the projects will continue or add to other sidewalk projects near schools and in high foot traffic areas.

The first sidewalk to be built if the city receives the County's portion of the funds will be on Morningside Boulevard, from Port St. Lucie Boulevard to Lyngate Drive. Some of the other locations high on the list include parts of Tulip, California and Morningside boulevards.
