PSL NOW IN MODIFIED PHASE II WATER-USE RESTRICTION STATUS

Port St. Lucie, FL – July 17, 2007 – The South Florida Water Management District has issued a **Modified Phase II** water shortage declaration the City of Port St. Lucie, limiting all landscape irrigation to two days a week and four hours a day, however, **restrictions on all other uses of water are lifted.**

Other outdoor water uses, such as low-volume pressure cleaning, and car and boat washing, are no longer restricted; agricultural, industrial, commercial, golf course, and recreational water uses also are no longer restricted.

Addresses that end in an odd number may water Wednesdays and Saturdays from 4 a.m. to 8 a.m.; homes, businesses and government facilities with even-number addresses may water Thursdays and Sundays from 4 a.m. to 8 a.m.

The **Modified Phase II** restrictions apply to users who obtain their water from the Port St. Lucie Utilities Services Department, private wells, canals, ponds and lakes.
