Prior to testing for the position of POLICE OFFICER with the City of Port St. Lucie, an individual must meet the following criteria:

1. Good moral character never convicted of any Felony, or any Misdemeanor involving moral turpitude.
2. Over age 19
3. Law Enforcement (Military or Civilian) or Corrections experience **desired** but not required.
4. Prior or current Military experience **desired** but not required.
5. College education **preferred** but not required.
6. Preference will be given to those applicants who have graduated, or are currently enrolled in a Florida State approved police academy
7. U.S. Citizen

POSITION SUMMARY: General duty police work enforcing laws and ordinances related to the protection of life and property, directing and controlling traffic, preventing crime or disturbance of peace, and arresting suspected violators by performing the following duties.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from an accredited high school or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma. Bachelor's degree (B.A. or B.S.) from an accredited four-year college or university preferred. If served in the military, an honorable discharge is required. Completion of the Minimum Standards courses as set forth by the Florida Police Standards Council preferred. Florida Law Enforcement Certification preferred. Valid Florida Driver's License and maintenance of clean driving record.

A comparable amount of training, education or experience may be substituted for the minimum qualifications.

ADA PROFILE: While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is regularly required to talk and hear. The employee is frequently required to sit. The employee is occasionally required to stand; walk; use hands to finger, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance. The employee may occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and ability to adjust focus.
