The City of Port St. Lucie seeks public input for Winterlakes Park conceptual plan

- What:** At the request of City Council, a second public meeting regarding the development of Winterlakes Park has been scheduled. Winterlakes Park, located at 5241 N.W. Jannebo Street, is a 28 acre, partially developed park site in an area of Port St. Lucie that is considered underserved for recreational facilities.
- When:** Wednesday, August 30, 2017 at 5:30 p.m.
- Where:** PSL Community Center, 2195 S.E. Airoso Blvd, Port St. Lucie, Room A.
- Why:** City Council discussed the process to develop a conceptual master plan for Winterlakes Park at its meeting on Monday, August 14th, 2017. During the discussion, citizens addressed the Council regarding the proposed conceptual design of the park. Ultimately, the City Council's consensus was to direct staff to return to the Winterlakes community and hold a second public meeting. The public is invited to meet with City staff and the consultant Cotleur and Hearing to gain citizen input in designing the conceptual master plan for Winterlakes Park as a neighborhood park. Recreational amenities that were deemed appropriate for development in the park include unlighted ball fields, unlighted soccer/multi-use fields, a dog park, children's play area, walking trails and the continued utilization of the existing airnasium. City will take this opportunity to listen to the public's requests for recreational amenities that are appropriate in a neighborhood park.
