City of Port St. Lucie offers Affordable Youth and Teen Summer Camp Options

PORT ST. LUCIE – The City’s Parks & Recreation Department will host three fun-filled camps this summer aimed at filling your child’s day with age appropriate activities and field trips.

The \$82 fee per child per week includes field trips. Certain field trips during the X-Treme Teen Camp will have an additional cost. There is a \$5 discount for each additional child registered for camp. Each session must be paid in full seven days in advance. To reserve your space, 50 percent of the balance is due at the time of registration.
