Other Accomplishments

The City of Port St. Lucie, in partnership with the Community Land Trust of Palm Beach County and the Treasure Coast, has a homeownership program that uses a CLT model. Also, since the beginning of the SHIP Program, we have had a unique "contract" with local lenders that benefits our down payment assistance recipients and the SHIP housing program in general. Members of the St. Lucie/Martin Lending Consortium offer a uniform lending package that provides special terms, with a reduction in closing staff to control the leveraging of funds, steering our program participants away from "predatory" lenders that might charge more for their services.
