The City of Port St. Lucie is currently accepting applications for a position on the **CONTRACTORS' EXAMINING BOARD**. The Board is appointed by the City Council to pass on applications for contractors' Certificates of Competency, as well as to hear complaints against local contractors. The Board meets on the second Thursday of each month at 9:30 a.m.

The Board consists of seven members, and terms are for two years. Members are subject to the provisions of the Sunshine Law and serve on a voluntary basis. All contractors serving on the board shall hold either a current Florida state contractor's license or a certificate of competency issued by the city and shall also carry valid insurance and Workers' Compensation, as required by law. The City Building Official, or its designee, shall serve as an ex officio member and shall not vote.

The open position: shall be a Consumer Member (lay person), who is not, and has never been engaged in the construction industry, or any closely related profession. Members must be residents of the City of Port St. Lucie for a continuous period of one (1) year immediately prior to appointment. Applicants are required to submit a brief resumé along with the application.
